# MECHANICAL DRAWING AND DESIGN. COURSE A—HONOURS.

#### Instructions.

  - (c) The same number of marks is allotted to each question.

## ONE QUESTION ONLY TO BE ATTEMPTED.

- 1. Draw a design for a Strip-poster, 20 inches by 8 inches (horizontal), to advertise one of the following:—
  - (a) "Gifts for Men", or
  - (b) "Gifts for Women", or
  - (c) "Gifts for Children".

Scale:  $\frac{1}{2}$  full-size.

Simple "One-stroke" lettering may be used to indicate the title or announcement.

Complete as much of the design as possible in colour.

2. Draw a design for a square Napkin or Serviette, of 14 inches side. The design should be suitable for Embroidery, or Damask Weaving, and may include an Initial-letter, or Monogram.

Scale: ½ full-size.

Complete as much of the design as possible in colour.

3. Make a design for an "All-over" repeating pattern for a Book-cover.

The unit of repeat is 1½ inches square, and the design is to be suitable for a book on one of the following subjects:—

- (a) "Alphabets", or
- (b) "Needlework", or
- (c) "Nature Study".

The size of the cover is 6 inches by 9 inches (vertical).

A blank space may be left for the title.

Complete as much of the design as possible in colour.

4. Draw a design, full-size, for the back of a Hand-mirror (handle to be omitted).

The design is to occupy a circle of 5½ inches diameter, and should be suitable for Leathereraft, Painted Wood, or Metalwork and Enamelling.

Complete as much of the design as possible in colour.

5. Draw a design for a Door-mat, 14 inches by 28 inches, suitable for a Hall the general colour-scheme of which is Red, Black, Grey and Blue.

The design may be based on a rectangle, or a diamond shape, or on a semicircle.

Scale: 1 full-size.

Complete as much of the design as possible in colour.
