ONE QUESTION ONLY TO BE ATTEMPTED.—(100 marks.)

- 1. Draw a design for a Strip-poster, 8 inches by 20 inches (horizontal), to advertise one of the following :—
 - (a) "Dyes," or
 - (b) "Glassware," or
 - (c) "Pottery."

Scale: ½ full-size.

Simple "one stroke" lettering may be used to indicate the title or announcement.

Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

2. Draw a design for a Door-mat, 16 inches by 28 inches, suitable for a Hall, the general colour-scheme of which is Cream, Orange and Brown.

The design may be based on a rectangle, or on a diamond shape, or on a semi-circle.

Scale: 1 full-size.

Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

3. Make a design for a Hanging-sign, to be suspended over the door of one of the following buildings:—(a) "A Jeweller," or (b) "A Café." or (c) "A Toy Shop."

The design may be any ornamental shape, 24 inches by 32 inches outside measurements, including moulding or frame.

Scale: 1 full-size.

Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

4. Make a design, to scale, or full-size, suitable for printing on a Cotton Handkerchief, 10 inches square.

Not more than four colours may be used.

Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

5. Make a design in colour, for an Embroidered, Stencilled, or Woven Table-cloth. The design is to occupy a square of 36 inches side. Scale: ‡ full-size.

At least one quarter of the design should be completed in colour.
