

1. Design a abstract pattern suitable for curtains or frock material. Complete as much as possible.

2. Design two grotesque masks, roughly life size, representing (a) Tragedy and (b) Comedy. The masks are to be used for a Theatre Festival. Work in colour.

3. Design a wrapping paper for one of the following articles:- Fruit, Wine, Flowers. Avoid a naturalistic treatment.

4. Design a poster for one of the following:- A Toy Fair, The Olympic Games, A Dog Show, A Flying Display. Appropriate lettering should be included. Work as large as possible.

5. Write out the following verses in pen lettering to fit a $\frac{1}{4}$ -imperial sheet of paper (15" x 11").


*3. Draw the pattern shown according to the dimensions given. The triangles A, B, C and D are equilateral.
