SECTION I - (100 marks)

ONE QUESTION ONLY TO BE ATTEMPTED

1. Design a poster to advertise one of the following:- A Book Sale; A Motor Show; Prevent Famine. Appropriate lettering should be incorporated in the design. Work as large as possible.

2. Design a decorative wall panel, or mural  $6' \times 4'$ , for a restaurant to be executed in one of the following techniques:- painting; mosaic; coloured glass; applique and embroidery; ceramic tiles. Your design should be based on, or derived from, some typical aspect, or feature of, Irish life or country side. State the technique for which your design would be most suitable. Work to as large a scale as possible.

3. Design an all-over pattern for a wrapping paper suitable for one of the following:- A Music Shop; a Cake Shop; a Gift or Souvenir Shop. Complete as large an area of the pattern as possible.

4. Design a record sleeve, or cover,  $12'' \times 12''$ , suitable for a record of either Irish Ballads, or, Ballet Music.

5. Draw in pencil a rectangle,  $10'' \times 13''$  upright. In this space draw with a lettering pen, or pens, the following piece of poetry:-

About the time when Christ was born,  
When the long wars for the White Horn  
And the Brown Bull had not yet come,  
Young Baile Honey-Mouth, whom some

\*1. The diagram shows the elevation and plan of a fluted, (semicircles) lampshade. Draw the development of the lampshade according to the given dimensions.



2. An elliptical table-top is to be made from a piece of wood  $7' \times 4'$ . Working to a scale of  $1''$  to  $1'$  draw the largest ellipse it is possible to make from the piece of wood, using any geometrical method of drawing.

\*3. The diagram shown is composed of portions of circles and their common tangents. Draw the diagram according to the given dimensions.

\*4. A regular hexagonal slab,  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  side and  $\frac{3}{4}''$  thick, lying on the horizontal plane supports a triangular pyramid so that three points of the base of the pyramid coincide with alternate points of the hexagonal slab. Draw the plan and elevation and an end view looking in the direction of the arrow A, according to the given dimensions.

5. Design a pattern based on interlaced arcs to fill a regular pentagon  $3''$  side.
