6. Draw a design for a Poster to advertise "Flower Seeds".

The design is to be rectangular in shape, 5 inches by 7 inches (vertical).

Not more than four colours may be used.

7. Draw a design for the decoration of a Bellows.

The design is to occupy a circle of 5 inches diameter, and should be suitable for Leathercraft, Painted Wood or Metalwork and Enamelling.

(Colour MAY be used in answering this question.)

8. Draw a design for a repeating border 2 inches wide, to suit a circular Photograph Frame of 8 inches diameter.

The design may be composed of Celtic, Floral or Geometric ornament, and should be suitable for Woodcarving, Repoussé Metal, Leathercraft, Painted Wood, or Inlay.

Complete one repeat and show the main lines of the adjacent repeats.

7. Draw a design for the decoration of a Bellows.


