- 1. Draw a design for a Poster or Showcard 8 inches by 10 inches (vertical), to advertise one of the following:—
 - (a) "Chocolates," or
 - (b) "Biscuits," or
 - (c) "Fruit."

Simple "one stroke" lettering may be used to indicate the title or announcement.

Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

2. Draw a design to be placed on a cylindrical Lampshade of the following dimensions:—Diameter 7 inches, Depth 6 inches.

The design must be composed of at least three repeats. Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

3. Draw a design for a "Pram" Cover, 3 feet by 2 feet. Scale: $\frac{1}{4}$ full-size.

The design should be suitable for Embroidery, Appliqué or Stencilling. Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

4; Make a design for an "all-over" repeating pattern for a Book-cover.

The unit of repeat is $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches square, and the design is to be suitable for a book on *one* of the following subjects:—(a) "Music," or (b) "Botany," or (c) "History."

The size of the cover is 6 inches by 9 inches (vertical). A blank space may be left for the title.

Complete in colour, as much as possible of the design.

5. Draw a design for the cover of a Catalogue to advertise "Flower Seeds."

The size of the cover is to be 5 inches by 8 inches (vertical). Complete in *two* colours, as much as possible of the design.
