Instructions to candidates

1. The coursework you submit for assessment must be your own individual work.
2. Your coursework must be executed in school under the supervision of your teacher.
3. Please familiarise yourself with the adjusted assessment arrangements for candidates taking the state examinations in the 2023/24 school year, that were issued by the Department of Education. As a result of these adjustments only **two** of the three sheets in the project must be presented. The third sheet is not examinable and will not have marks allocated to it. Therefore, candidates are only required to complete the following two sheets in 2024:

- **Sheet 1** - Selection and investigation of chosen object
- **Sheet 2** - Measured drawings

Your coursework should be presented as two single-sided A3 pages.

As a result of these changes, the total mark allocation for this coursework in 2024 is 80 marks, instead of the usual 120 mark total. However, the relative weighting between the coursework (30%) and the written paper (70%) will be retained. This will be achieved by reweighting the coursework before it is combined with the mark for the written component.

4. Original sketches and drawings **must** be submitted throughout the project, scanned images will not suffice.
5. When using research sources, including the Internet and material generated using artificial intelligence (AI) software or applications, the sources must be acknowledged. Material copied directly from the Internet or from other sources and presented as your own work will not receive any marks.
6. The coursework presented for assessment must be displayed in an attractive manner and marks will be awarded for presentation.
7. Circulars S68/04, S69/08, and S76/22 outline the requirements for authentication and acceptance of coursework.
8. It is your responsibility, as the candidate, to comply with these instructions. If you fail to comply with these instructions, your teacher will not be able to validate and sign off on your coursework and you will not receive any marks for it.
9. Your **Examination Number** should be written clearly on **all** pages submitted.
10. The coursework must be completed by **24 November 2023**.
11. The completed coursework should be retained in school until the written examination in Graphics. The coursework of each candidate will be sent to the SEC with their written examination.

N.B. No further work should be undertaken on the Student Project after 24 November 2023 as to do so would render the project invalid and could lead to marks being withheld.

Note:

- *The circumstances in which the Minister for Education may withhold marks from candidates are set out in the "Rules and Programme for Secondary Schools".*
- *Anyone who helps a candidate to break examination rules can be prosecuted under the Education Act 1998.*

Graphics - Student Project Brief 2024

Tea lights and holders are often used to create a pleasant ambiance.

Tea light holders are available in a range of shapes, sizes, and materials; from single standalone designs to holders which accommodate a number of tea lights.

Carry out a **graphical investigation** of a tea light holder.

Your investigation should include an analysis of physical form, shape, underlying geometry, proportion, colour, materials, etc.

Note: For 2024, the total marks for the coursework will be 80 marks instead of 120 marks. The 30% coursework weighting (120 marks) will be retained by reweighting the coursework mark before it is combined with the mark for the written component.
