- 2. Draw a design for a square tablemat, 8" side. The design should be suitable for embroidery, weaving, or fabric printing.
- 3. Make a design for a hanging sign to be placed over the door of one of the following:—(a) a Sports Shop; (b) a Book Shop; (c) a Flower Shop.
- 4. Draw a design for a carpet based on a repeating pattern. The design should be suitable for a sitting room the general colour scheme of which is grey and pale yellow.

- *1. The drawing shows the plan and elevation of a lampshade.
 Make a development of it according to the dimensions shown.
- *2. Draw the diagram to the given dimensions. Show the constructions for determining the centres of the circular arcs.
 - *3. Draw the diagram to the dimensions given.
- 4. Draw a pattern using interlocking arcs to fill a circle. Radius of circle, 3".
- 5. Inscribe eight equal circles in a square of 6" side, each circle to touch one side of the square and two other circles.
