

The program of the meeting will include a series of three lectures by Gigliola Staffilani of MIT and six plenary lectures by outstanding women mathematicians selected by the Scientific Committee of the EWM, chaired by Cornelia Drutu of the University of Oxford. The plenary speakers come from six different countries and cover a wide range of topics in mathematics. There will also be four specialised sessions of invited talks, on subjects of current interest.
